The closing market price and NAV are based on data as of November 3, 2022. The Market Price Distribution Rate is calculated by dividing the latest declared monthly distribution per share (annualized) by the market price. The NAV Distribution Rate is calculated by dividing the latest declared monthly distribution per share (annualized) by the NAV per share.

The funds are closed-end investment companies. Five of these funds trade on the New York Stock Exchange (NYSE) under the following symbols: MHI, MAV, PHT, PHD, and MIO; HNW trades on the NYSEAMER.
